TERMS AND CONDITIONS

I agree to participate in the IGLFA Sydney World Championship competition in accordance with the Constitution, Rules & Regulations, Code(s) of Conduct and policies of the Organising Body (WP23 Tournament Inc). I also agree to participate in the tournament in accordance with the Laws of the Game and display at all times behaviour that is not detrimental to myself, my opponents, my club, the Organising Body or the game of football.

I acknowledge that nothing in the Rules and Regulations will prevent the Organising Body from approving a course of action to meet unforeseeable circumstances not covered by the Rules and Regulations.

I acknowledge that football is conducted at venues provided by the Inner West Council and accept responsibility for any injury or illness arising from my participation in activities at such venues where these fixtures are conducted. Further, upon participating in football activities at such venues, I release and discharge the Organising Body and its volunteers from any claim, suit, demand, expense or cost in respect of any injury or illness arising out of or in connection with my participation in football activities at such venues.

I am aware of the Organising Body's Refund Policy and Privacy Policy. I am also aware of and commit to abiding by the other policies available on the Tournament website, including: Zero Tolerance for Discrimination and Violence, LGBTIQ+ Diversity and Inclusion, Accessibility, Non-Gendered Dress Code and Facilities, and Disciplinary and Grievance Handling policies. I understand that the Organising Body may refine these policies prior to the commencement of the Tournament and that these will be made available on the website for all participants prior to the Tournament via the website.

To all Players, Team Officials and Supporters,

The Organising Body aims to conduct the most inclusive LGBTQIA+ tournament in the world. With this in mind, the Organising Body has endorsed a Zero Tolerance policy in relation to discrimination and violence within our Tournament.

This Zero Tolerance policy has been communicated in the lead up to the tournament and is endorsed by the member organisations (The Flying Bats, The Sydney Rangers FC and Pride Football Australia) of the Organising Body.

We have no intention of allowing discrimination of any kind, violence, verbal and physical abuse towards officials, other players, or spectators. Additionally, bullying or abuse of match officials will not be tolerated.
